<b>1. To increase confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.</b>	
<p><u>Sports Coach to share planning and team teaching during lessons</u> – PE planning and assessments will be shared by our sports coach and class teacher to ensure that all staff are aware of content and coverage and is able to make assessments.</p> <p><b>Expenditure</b> <b>Cost of PE platform</b></p>	<p>Teachers will feel confident in the teaching and assessment of PE. PE monitoring shows that teaching in PE is of a high standard and assessments are accurate across all areas.</p>
<p><u>Team Teach each week with sports coach</u> - One PE lesson per week will be delivered by the class teacher and sports coach, this will allow teacher to learn and become familiar with planning and assessments.</p> <p><b>No additional cost</b></p>	<p>Teachers will feel confident in the teaching and assessment of PE. PE monitoring shows that teaching in PE is of a high standard and assessments are accurate across all areas.</p>
<p><u>Ensure teachers have access to and are confident in the use of the PE passport</u> – Staff meeting time will be allocated to support teachers with using the PE passport.</p> <p><b>No additional cost</b></p>	<p>PE assessments are consistent across school and recorded on the PE passport. All teachers have access to the passport and are confident in its use for both planning and assessment.</p>
<p><u>Provide recognised and quality CPD for teachers</u> – Teachers will provide feedback on areas they need further CPD.</p> <p><b>No additional cost</b> - Although training identified by new subject lead for Autumn 2025</p>	<p>PE lead to identify areas for CPD through regular monitoring. Training to be booked through BSSP or LPDS.</p>
<p><u>Assess and evaluate PE data termly</u> – Data will be analysed by class teachers, SLT and PE lead each term to identify trends and areas for development. Interventions will be led by sports coach where children require additional support to reach standard are if the are working beyond ARE in order to reach greater depth.</p>	<p>Data will be analysed as part of the pupil progress meetings with SLT and PE lead to review and identify children requiring additional support within lessons or through interventions. Teachers will have a clear understanding which children in their class are working at ARE, GDS and below ARE for each area of PE.</p>

<p>Governor training on PE premium – Training will be provided for governors so they are confident with the requirements and expectations of the sports premium grant.</p> <p><b>No additional cost</b></p>	<p>Governors have a clear understanding of requirements and expectation of the Sports Premium grant and are part of the monitoring process.</p> <p>Sports Governor to have a clear and confident understanding of spending.</p>
<p>Training for new sports lead – a new sports lead took up role in January 2025. Training will be provided to ensure that they are confident and supported in their new role.</p> <p><b>Expenditure</b></p> <p><b>Cost of course</b></p>	<p>Sports lead will have a clear understanding of their role and essential policies and procedures.</p> <p>Sports lead will deliver training on the PE passport to staff and will keep teachers and SLT up to date with information from BSSP.</p>

<p>Conduct pupil voice to understand children's interests and views of our current offering</p> <p><b>No additional cost</b></p>	<p>All children will have the opportunity to engage in regular (daily) physical activity. There will be a variety of different opportunities and experiences open to the children.</p>
<p>Develop playtime and lunchtime provision to promote physical activity – New equipment to make lunchtimes and playtime more active. Staff will play games with the children to keep them active.</p> <p><b>Expenditure</b></p> <p><b>Cost of play equipment</b></p> <p><b>Cost of forest School Provision</b></p>	<p>Children's voice will be collected to see what equipment/provision children and enjoy and would like.</p> <p>Playtimes and lunchtimes will be organized to ensure that all children have the opportunity and space to move more and be more active.</p>
<p>Train play leaders to engage other children in physical activity – Year 6 children are trained in September as play leaders. Once trained the teach KS1 children new games and keep them active during break and lunchtimes.</p> <p><b>No additional cost (BSSP)</b></p>	<p>Playleaders will help younger children to learn new games and stay engaged in physical activity for longer periods of time during the day.</p>

We offer a wide range of activities to extend children's knowledge and experience of physical activity.
