We follow the Local Authority Term-Time Leave guidance and a family holiday does not meet the exceptional leave criteria. We would ask that all holidays are taken outside of term-time please. Any parent/carer still wishing to take their child out of school during term time, must complete a Local Authority Term-Time Leave form which can be requested from the school office.

Medical Appointments

We would ask that where possible medical appointments for your child are made outside of school hours, but when this is unavoidable please may we ask that they are out of school for as shorter a time as possible and we must see proof of appointment please or their absence will be have to be marked as unauthorised.
